Local Business Enterprise Preference Program

- Local Business Enterprise Preference Program for the procurement of Goods, Equipment and Services, including Construction, valued in excess of \$150,000
- REQUEST FOR BIDS
 - 8% preference (discount) applied to bids of Local Business Enterprise (LBE) certified companies or a preference of up to 5% applied for a LBE certified Subcontractor to perform work under the contract
 - 1% preference, up to a maximum of 5%, applied to the quoted bid price for every 10% of the cost of the proposed work by a LBE Subcontractor

Local Business Enterprise Preference Program

- REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP)
 - 8% (of total possible evaluation points) preference (credit) applied to evaluation score of proposals of LBE certified companies or a preference of up to 5% applied for a LBE certified Subcontractor to perform work under the contract
 - 1% preference credit , up to a maximum of 5%, applied to the evaluation score for every 10% of the cost of the proposed work by a LBE Subcontractor
- Affidavit of Eligibility must be posted on LABAVN (Mayor's website) by bid/proposal due date

Local Business Enterprise Preference Program

- Principal office located in the County of Los Angeles
- City of Los Angeles Business Tax Registration Certificate (BTRC)
- Compliance with all applicable business licensing laws and not delinquent on any City of Los Angeles or County taxes
- The certification process is simple. Affidavit of Eligibility completed and posted by Local Business on LABAVN (Mayor's website)
- Verification by Bureau of Contract Administration
- Certification is valid for two years

Local Business Enterprise Preference Program

- The maximum bid preference shall not exceed \$1 million for any bid
- LBPP does not apply to contracts that involve the expenditure of funds that are not entirely within LAWA's control, such as state and federal grant fund or that are procured under federal regulations
- LBPP does not apply to Ontario-specific projects
