



## Runway Status Light Project

On Saturday, January 26, 2013 at 12:00 am, Runway 7L-25R is scheduled to be closed continuously until Sunday, February 3, 2013 at 2:00 pm. The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) will begin installing additional infrastructure for the Runway Status Light (RWSL) system that is currently in use at Los Angeles International Airport (LAX). While this is the first phase of the 8-month long project, it is expected that this will be the only multiple day runway closure related to this project. A Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) will be issued 48-72 hours prior to the scheduled closure. Please plan your flight operations accordingly.
