



Relocation of Copa Airlines from Terminal 6 to Terminal 3 on April 7, 2017

Airport and airline staff will relocate 28 airlines as part of Delta Airlines' move from Terminals 5 and 6 to Terminals 2 and 3. The majority of the relocation will take place beginning on May 12th for several days.

As part of the realignment of airlines, Copa Airlines will move their operations from Terminal 6 to Terminal 3 on April 7, 2017. Copa passengers will check-in at Terminal 3 and passengers will be directed to Tom Bradley International Terminal (TBIT) for security screening and departure from TBIT Gates. Arriving passengers on Copa flights will be processed and cleared through Federal Inspection Services at TBIT.

All airport employees, tenants, stakeholders, and service providers are advised to note the change and disseminate information to all concerned. Roadway overhead signs will be updated to show Copa Airlines departing from Terminal 3 and overhead sign for Parking Structure 3 will also list Copa Airlines.
