1. APM Guideway Construction

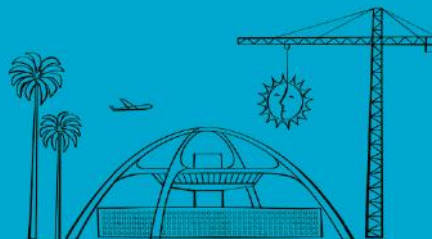
- The APM project is constructing the portion of elevated guideway that will connect the existing guideway portions on either side of Century Boulevard, as pictured below
- Daytime (M-F 9AM to 3:30PM; Sat 8AM to 6PM) lane restrictions in both directions are required through August 30 to facilitate this work
- A nightly (M-F 12AM to 4AM) full closure of the eastbound Century Boulevard Ramp from the Departures Level Airport Exit / northbound Sepulveda Boulevard will be needed August 23 – 30 for this work
- Detours and signage will be in place during all restrictions / closures to assist with wayfinding

2. Terminal Core Progress Updates:

- Glass panel installation and façade work continues on all active Terminal Core projects with great progress being made around the Central Terminal Area
- At Terminal 2 / 3 (pictured below, top), mechanical screening is being installed on top of the future Head House to shield all mechanical equipment on top of the building from public view
- At Terminal B (pictured below, bottom), glass panels continue to be installed to complete the new face of the international terminal; the area open on the left is where the future Terminal B Pedestrian Bridge to the Automated People Mover's West CTA Station will connect
