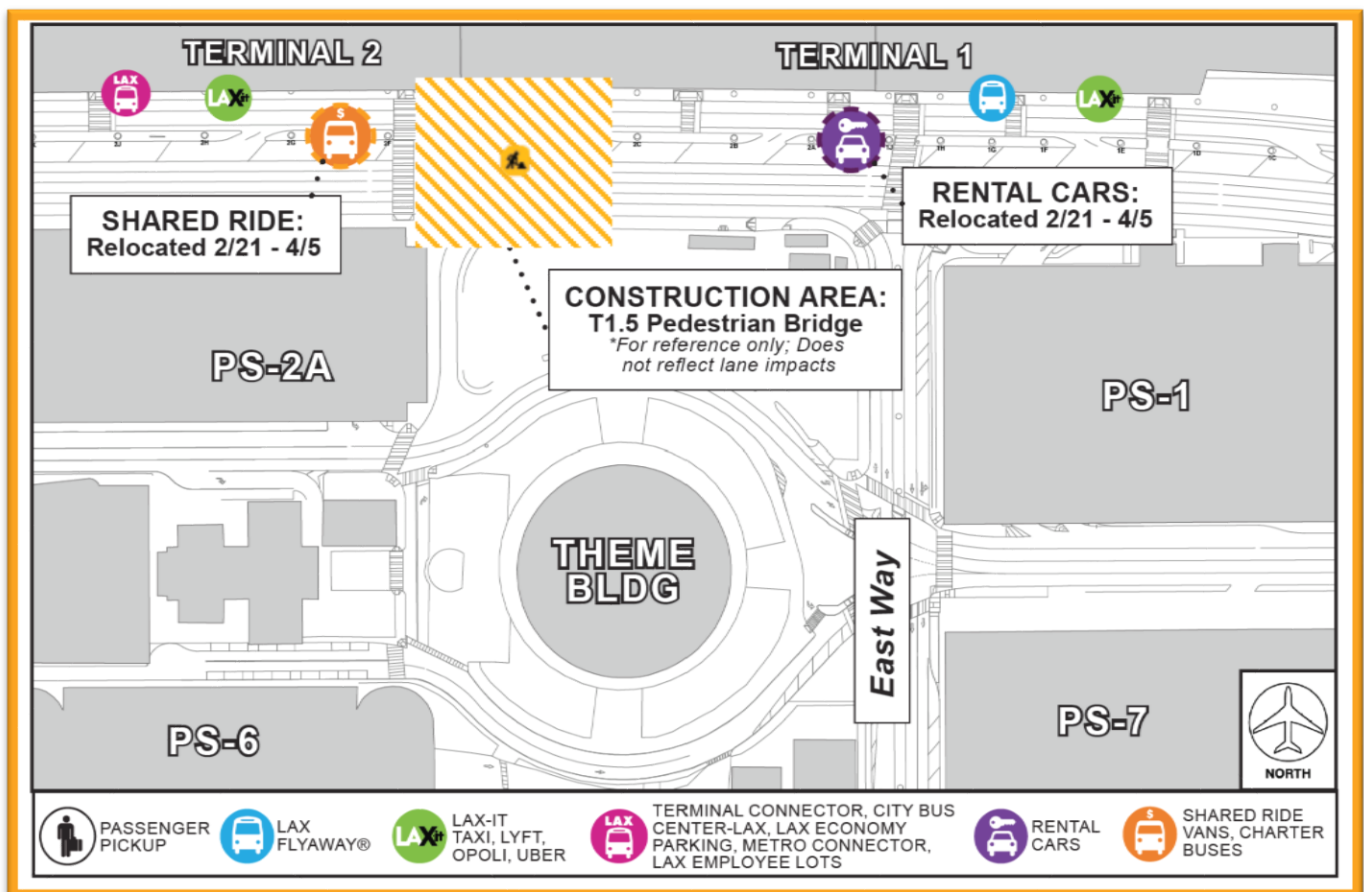

1. Automated People Mover: Terminal 1.5 Pedestrian Bridge

- Construction of a Pedestrian Bridge to connect Terminal 1.5 to the APM's Center CTA Station begins this week
- Nightly lane restrictions and / or full closures on Arrivals and Departures Level roadways are required through early April to facilitate construction
- Detour and temporary wayfinding signage, along with flaggers, will be utilized to maintain traffic and pedestrian flow during construction
- Two Arrivals Level Ground Transportation stops have been temporarily relocated to facilitate this work

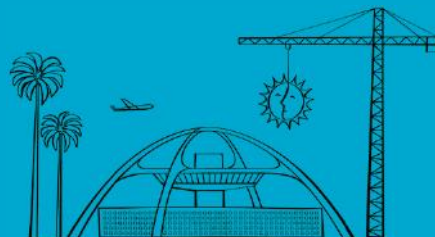


Terminal 3 Pedestrian Bridge (January 2022) for reference

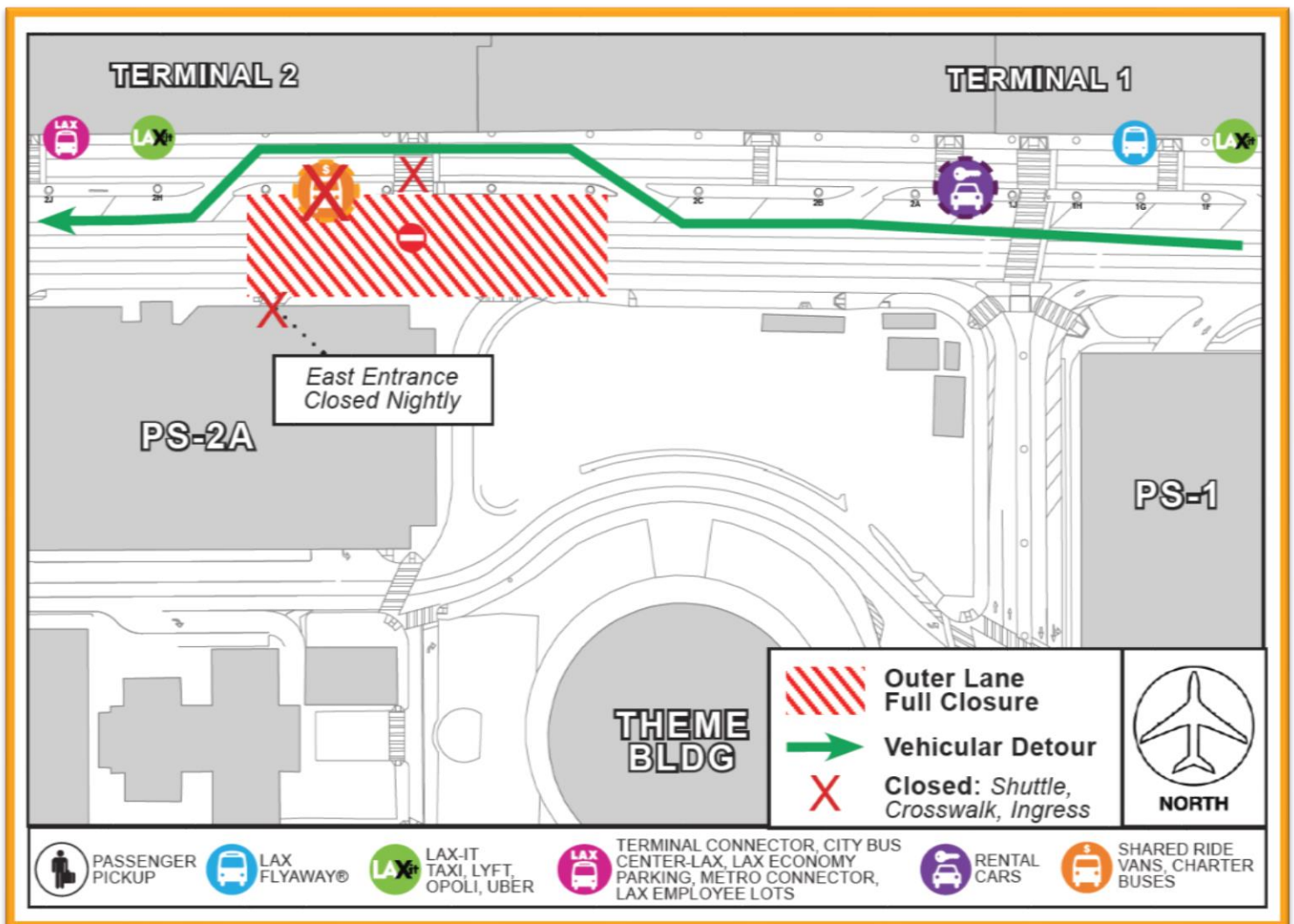

1. Terminal 1.5: Pedestrian Bridge (continued)

- Full closures of Arrivals Level Outer Lanes are scheduled for the nights of Monday, February 21 to Wednesday, March 9, and Monday, April 4 during varying times between 10PM and 7AM
- During nightly closures, all traffic will be detoured to the Inner Lanes around construction
- The crosswalk and eastern ingress to Parking Structure 2A will be closed, along with the Shared Ride Van shuttle stop
- Detour and temporary wayfinding signage, along with flaggers, will be utilized to maintain traffic and pedestrian flow during construction



When Arrivals Level Outer Lanes are fully closed, vehicles are detoured to Inner Lanes

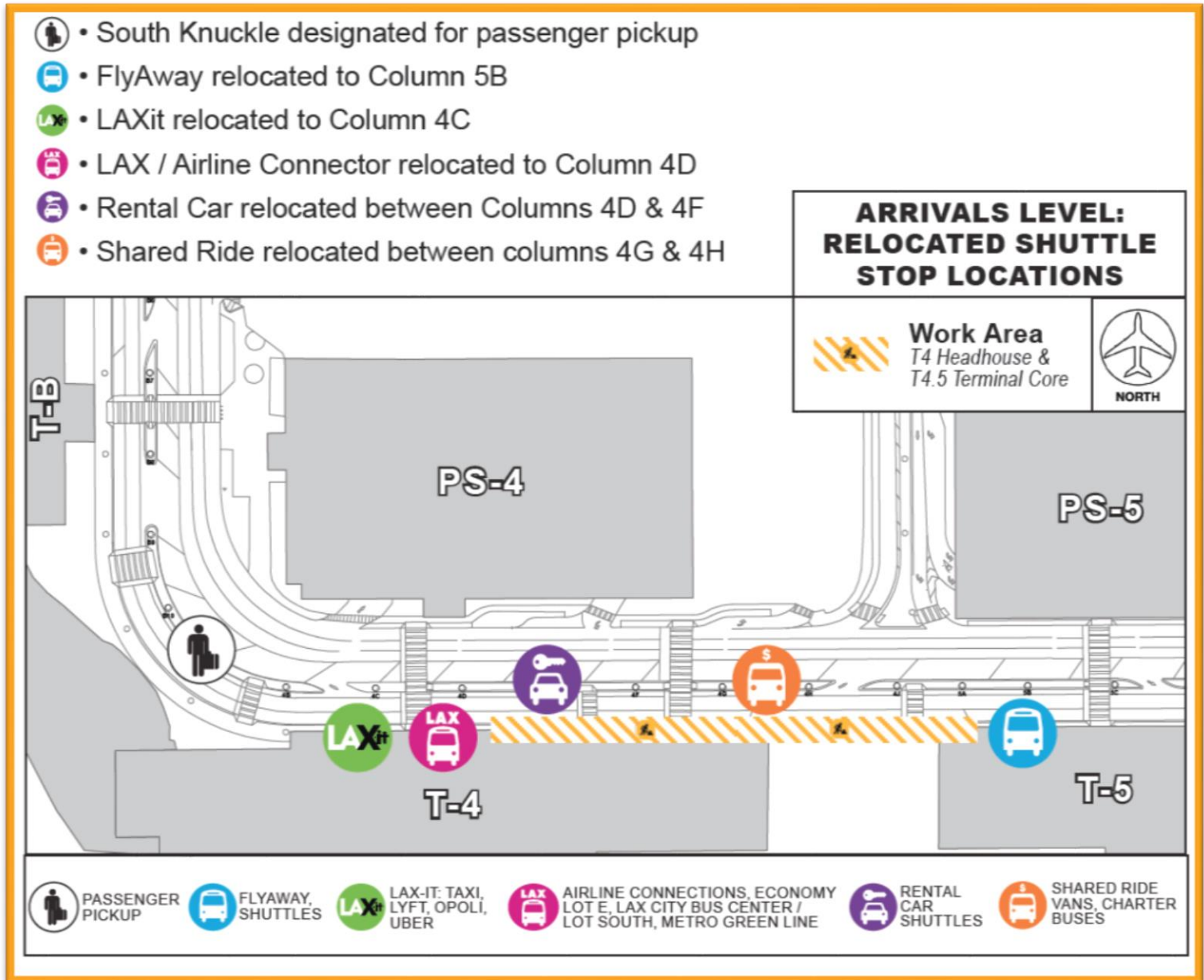

2. REMINDER Terminal 4: Modernization Program

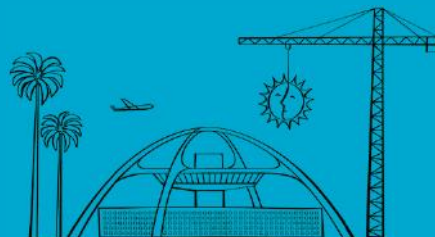
- Phase 1 of American Airlines' Terminal 4 Modernization Program started last week with major changes to the terminal's passenger flow and Ground Transportation stops
- On the Arrivals Level, existing Shuttle Stops have been relocated per the map below; signage is currently in place directing guests to relocated stops

- Construction for this program is ongoing through December 2025

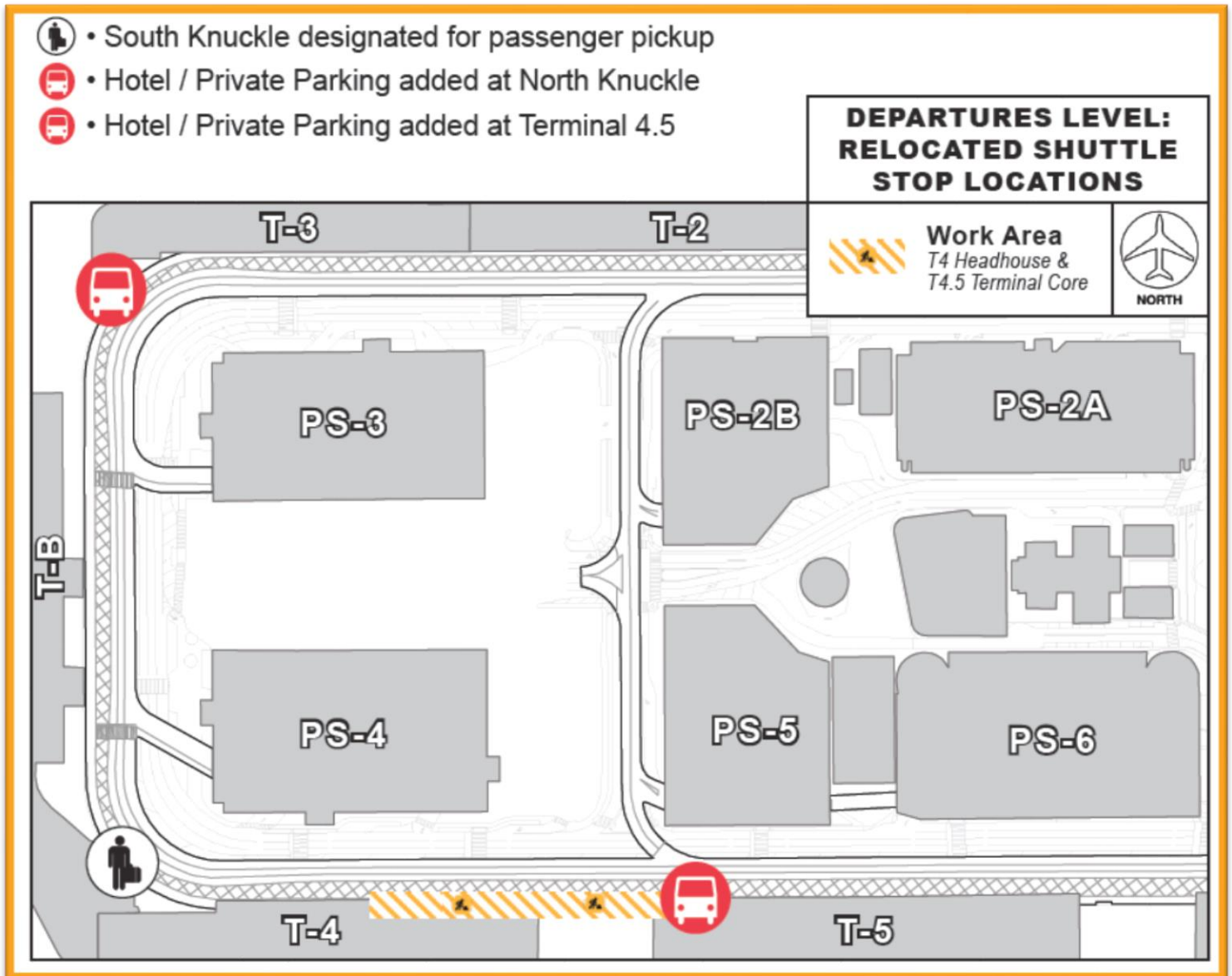

2. REMINDER Terminal 4: Modernization Program (continued)

- On the Departures Level, the South Knuckle (area between Terminal B & Terminal 4) has been re-designated from a Hotel / Private Parking Stop to a designated Passenger Drop Off zone
- New Hotel / Private Parking Stops have been added at the North Knuckle (area between Terminal 3 & Terminal B) as well as at Terminal 4.5 (area between Terminal 4 & Terminal 5)
- Signage is currently in place directing guests to new and relocated stops
