1. LAX Holiday Construction Moratoriums

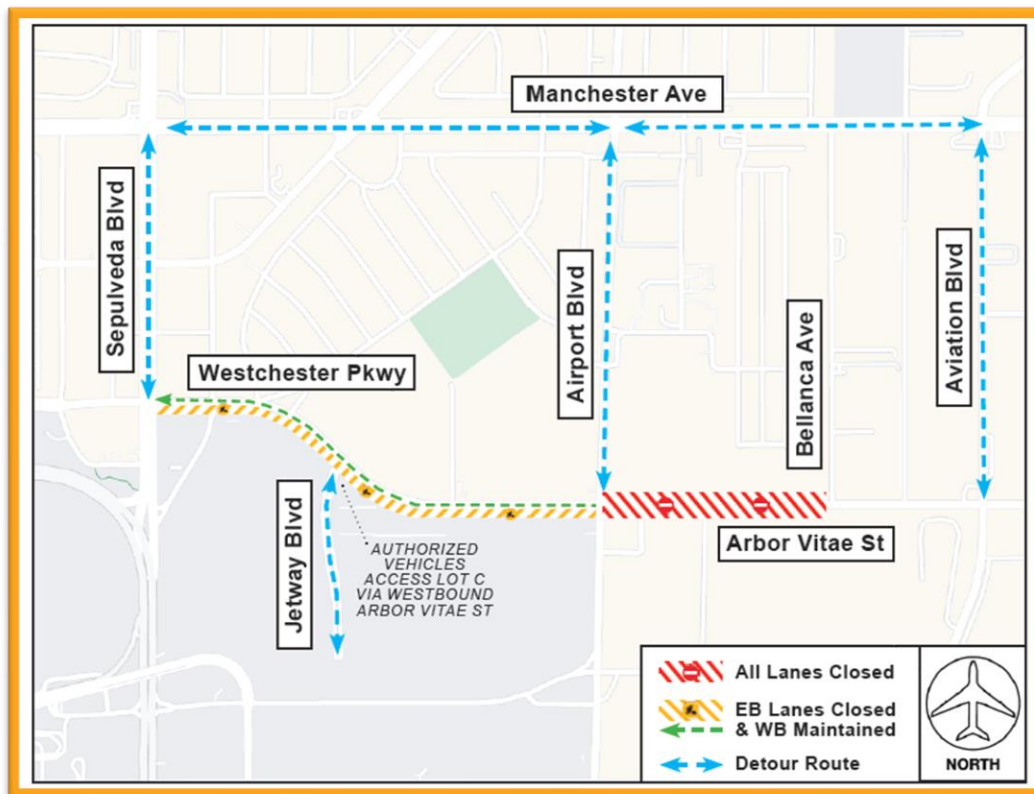
- As a reminder, the LAX Christmas & New Year's Holiday Moratorium will take place Monday, December 19, 2022 through Tuesday, January 3, 2023

2. City of Los Angeles Public Streets Holiday Construction Moratoriums

- In addition to LAX's Holiday Construction Moratorium, the City of Los Angeles will implement holiday season public street closure restrictions during weekends in December (Dec. 2 – 4, Dec. 9 – 11, and Dec. 16 – 25, 2022)

3. Roadway Impacts: Westchester Parkway / Arbor Vitae Street

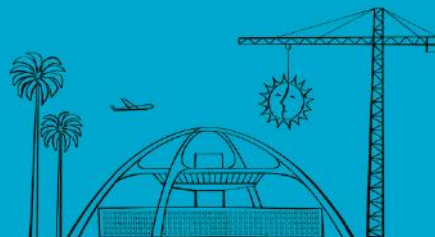
- To facilitate roadway paving and striping work, portions of Westchester Parkway and Arbor Vitae Street will experience the following impacts beginning Sat. Dec. 17 at 10PM continuous through Sun. Dec. 18 at 10AM (12 hours)
- Westchester Parkway between Sepulveda Boulevard and Airport Boulevard: Eastbound lanes closed; westbound lanes remain open
- Arbor Vitae Street between Airport Boulevard and Bellanca Avenue: All lanes closed



Detours will be in place while streets are closed for 12 hours for paving and striping

4. Automated People Mover: Project Updates & Milestones

- Work is ongoing to deliver two more Automated People Mover train cars this holiday season
- The first cars were unveiled in August 2022; there will be 44 train cars in total
- LAX will be the first U.S. airport to feature INNOVIA 300 APM vehicles, which are electric and made from fully recyclable aluminum shells designed to eliminate hazardous substances and toxic emissions
- Additionally, the LAX APM recently won an Envision Gold Award for Sustainable Infrastructure from the Institute for Sustainable Infrastructure, due in part to these energy-efficient train cars
